## Sydenham High St Proposals for Development

Tom Sutcliffe presented his concerns about the proposed changes. His main concern was the road narrowing produced by buildouts would decrease amount of space available to cyclists and therefore increase conflict between motorists and cyclists. He was also concerned about the threat to the safety of cyclists caused by these buildouts and described a personal experience he had already had due to one build out on a turn off the High St. Some discussion followed, Carole Crankshaw pointed out that LC had been involved in process through attendance of RC at development consultation meetings.

TS gave meeting details of next public consultation.

## Treasurer's Report

Lewisham membership is up by 6% from 394 to 417. LCC have increased per capita grant from 20 – 30p per head and LC have received £300 for participation in Freewheel and the Tour de France roadshow.

This leaves £880 in the budget.
